### *From Police Volunteer To Police Constable*

A volunteer at The Worth Valley Police and Community Contact Point is due to start a whole new career within the service as she is sworn in as a Police Constable with North Yorkshire Police.

Amy Blakeley, aged 19, is currently a volunteer at the Haworth Police & Community Contact Point but the community will soon sadly be saying goodbye to her as she embarks upon her life long ambition of becoming a Police Officer on her 20th birthday.

"I really enjoy being a Police volunteer because of all the different people I meet in the role," said Amy. "During my time as a volunteer I have learned all about different areas of policing from the local PCs and PCSOs, for example, issuing crime prevention advice and how working with partners helps to tackle anti-social behaviour. As a volunteer you really feel like you get to help people, even if someone just pops in for a chat because you know that you have at least made a difference to their day."

Sergeant Mark Wheeler of The Worth Valley NPT said, "We are all very pleased for Amy and our loss will be North Yorkshire's gain. It's been nice to see Amy develop her skills as a Police volunteer and her work at the Contact Point has definitely helped her in being successful with her application to become a Police Constable."

"Bingley & Worth Valley NPT are always seeking new volunteers to work alongside us and as can be seen in Amy's case it's an excellent way to start for anyone considering a career within the Police Service.
